RSC Condemns Terrorist Attack on Jerusalem Seminary

WASHINGTON, D.C. – One day after the House of Representatives passed an RSC authored resolution condemning the ongoing Palestinian rocket attacks on Israeli civilians by Hamas and other Palestinian terrorist organizations (H.Res 951), two terrorists attacked civilians at a Jewish seminary dining hall in Jerusalem killing at least 10 people. The authors of the resolution, RSC Chairman Jeb Hensarling (R-TX) and Congressman Scott Garrett (R-NJ), condemned the terrorist attack and issued the following statements:

RSC Chairman Jeb Hensarling (R-TX):

“Sadly, terrorists have struck again in Israel today, murdering and injuring peaceful civilians in a house of worship. We condemn this attack and believe that terrorists, whether acting on their own or as part of a violent Palestinian group or terrorist organization, must be held accountable for their brutal acts. We express our condolences to the Israeli government and the families of the victims.”

Congressman Scott Garrett (R-NJ):

“Today’s horrific attack is yet another example of the violence that terrorist organizations like Hamas and the Islamic Jihad inflict upon the people of Israel. These terrorists’ continually foster violence and hinder the peace process in the region. Before more innocent individuals become victims, the United States and the global community must condemn all forms of terrorism and embrace those citizens who desire to live in peace.”
